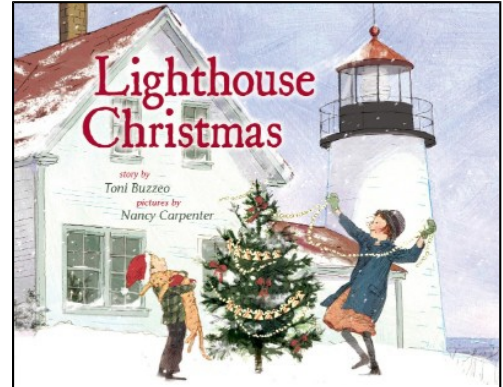


Teaching about Lighthouses
